Section 1: Art Projects

Paper Plate Carrot Garden | HF

Materials needed:

- Paper Plate
- **Green Construction Paper**
- Orange Construction Paper
- **Brown Tissue Paper**
- **Brown Construction Paper**
- Glue
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Pencil or Pen



1. First cut your paper plate in half. Straight up the center to make TWO equal halves.

Save one half of the paper plate for today's craft and the other for a rainy day!

- 2. Grab your brown tissue paper and cut/tear a small amount into small pieces to represent the dirt. Glue those pieces to the paper plate half.
- 3. Trace one of your hands on the orange construction paper. Use the scissors to trim around/out the traced handprint design from the paper.
- 4. Cut out small greenery from green paper for EACH fingertip of the handprint. This will give the look of carrots! Glue or staple those on to each fingertip.
- 5. Staple or glue the decorated orange handprint to the paper plate.
- 6. If desired cut out a simple worm from light brown cardstock paper to add to the paper plate piece.



Earth Paper Plate Project | HF | LF

Materials needed:

- Paper Plates
- Blue Paint
- Green Tissue Paper
- White Construction Paper
- Black Marker
- Googly Eyes
- Scissors
- Glue

- 1. Paint paper plate blue
- 2. Cut pieces of green paper and glue to paper plate.
- 3. Glue googly eyes to the plate and draw a mouth and any other facial features you may want with a marker.
- 4. Cut 4 strips of white paper. I cut 2 longer and wider for the legs. Accordion fold the strips of paper and glue or tape to the back of the paper plate so that your earth has arms and legs.



Clay Impressions | HF

Materials needed:

- Clay
- Flowers/Plants
- Rolling Pin
- Paint



- 1. Use rolling pin to roll clay into a flat oval shape
- 2. Next, place plant or flower on the center of your flattened clay
- 3. Use rolling pin again to flatten the plant/flower onto the clay and make the impression.
- 4. Carefully remove the plant/flower
- 5. Use paint to color in the impression if desired.
- 6. Optional: Now you may also use a stick or chopstick to make a hole at the top of your clay to run a piece of string or ribbon through to hang it

Spring Seed Bombs | HF | LF

Materials needed:

- 3-4 Packages of Flower Seeds
- Food Processor
- Scissors
- Water
- 3 Small Conatiners
- Baking Sheet and Parchment Paper
- 3 Sheets of Construction Paper (Blue, Green, White)



- 1. Start by cutting your construction paper into one-inch squares. Place each color separately in a container.
- 2. Once you have cut up all your paper squares and each container is ready, add water. Cover the paper completely and allow to soak for 20 minutes.
- 3. When the 20 minutes is finished (the hardest part is always waiting), take one container and squeeze the excess water out of the paper. Place the paper in a food processor and pulse until the paper becomes pulp!
- 4. Place the pulp back into its container. Go ahead and repeat with the next two colors until you have three containers of pulp!
- 5. Divide the packages of seeds between the three containers gently mixing them into the pulp.
- 6. Start by taking a bit of each color from each container and forming it into a ball! We wanted these to resemble the Earth for Earth Day. If you have chosen other colors that are great too! To make the Earth try not to mix up the colors too much.
- 7. Place your homemade seed bombs on a parchment lined baking tray. You can go ahead and press a few more seeds into the balls if you think they need a few more. Let your tray dry overnight.
- 8. Once dry, toss your flower seed bombs into your favorite flowerpot or garden plot.



Lava Lamp Science Experiment | HF

Materials needed:

- Cooking Oil
- Water
- Food Coloring
- Glass Jars
- Alka Seltzer Tablets

- 1. Fill your jar(s) about 2/3 of the way with oil. You can experiment with more and less and see which one gives the best results. Make sure to keep track of your results.
- 2. Next, you want to fill your jar(s) the rest of the way with water. Make sure to observe what happens to the oil and water in your jars as you add them.



- 3. Add drops of food coloring to your oil and water and watch what happens. However, you don't want to mix the colors into the liquids
- 4. Now it's time for the grand finale of this lava lamp science experiment! It's time to drop in a tablet of Alka Seltzer or it's generic equivalent. Make sure to watch closely as the magic starts to happen!

Earth Windsoch | LF | HF

Materials needed:

- blue cardstock (we used 65 lb.)
- green and blue tissue paper
- green acrylic paint
- clothespin
- large pom-pom
- paper plate
- green cardstock paper
- scissors
- glue stick
- stapler





- 1. Open up a clothespin and close it around a large craft pom-pom. This will be the paintbrush you use for making their craft.
- 2. Pour a small amount of green paint on a paper plate. Dip the end of the pom-pom into the green paint and then press it onto a sheet of blue cardstock to start creating the land masses on your Earth.
- 3. Continue dipping the pom-pom into the green paint and then stamping it all over the blue cardstock to make each of Earth's continents on your blue cardstock paper. Let your paint dry completely before moving onto the next step.
- 4. When your green paint has finished drying, turn your windsock over so the painted continents on the Earth are facing down. Cut out three pieces of 18-inch green tissue paper and three pieces of 18-inch blue tissue paper. Glue them on the bottom one-third of the blue cardstock.
- 5. Bend your Earth Day windsock into a circle, connecting the ends together. Place two staples at the top and bottom of the windsock to join the ends together.
- 6. Cut a green paper strip handle that is 1-inch by 8 1/2-inches. Add a generous amount of extra strength glue stick on each end of the paper strip and attach it inside the top of the windsock for a handle.

Q Tip Daisies | LF | HF

Materials needed:

- Q Tips
- Green Pipe Cleaners
- Yellow Playdough
- Blue Construction Paper

- 1. Start by cutting a handful of Q Tips in half
- 2. Roll a chunk of yellow playdough into a ball with your hands. Then flatten it slightly between your palms.
- 3. Press the Q Tip halves into the playdough around the outside to form the petals



- 4. Poke a green pipe cleaner into the playdough to form the stem
- 5. Glue another piece of folded pipe cleaner onto the stem to make a leaf.
- 6. Now you may choose to glue your flower down on some blue paper or keep it loose and put it into a vase.

Toilet Paper Roll Frog | LF | HF

Materials needed:

- Toilet Paper Rolls
- White Paper
- Black Paper
- Black Marker
- Paint
- Scissors
- Glue

- 1. Paint the toilet paper roll green and add eyes with black and white cardstock.
- 2. Draw on a smiley face with a black marker
- 3. Make two legs with extra toilet paper roll loops. Add a tongue from another piece of toilet paper roll cut out and painted pink
- 4. Add feet from other pieces of toilet paper roll painted green



Paper Plate Lady Bug | LF

Materials needed:

- Paper Plates
- Red Paint
- Black Construction Paper
- Googly Eyes
- Hole Punch
- Glue

Instructions:

 Start by painting the backside of a paper plate red



- 2. While the plate is drying cut out a black strip for the line on the back, a half circle or half oval shape for the head, a thin V shape for the antenna and punch out circles for the spots.
- 3. When the plate is dry, glue on all the things you cut out and add googly eyes.

Flower Pot Craft HF | LF

Materials needed:

- Construction Paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tissue Paper
- Paint or Markers
- Cupcake Liners

Instructions:

 Start out by painting for drawing the outline of your pot on a piece of construction paper.



- 2. Cut or rip various colors of tissue paper into one inch pieces and glue them inside of your pot outline.
- 3. Use paint or marker to make green stems coming out of the pot.
- 4. Decorate and color about 5-7 inside of cupcake liners. These will be your flowers.
- 5. Glue them at the end of the stems

Newspaper Flowers | LF

Materials needed:

- Newspaper
- Bottle Caps
- Paint
- Scissors
- Glue
- Construction Paper



- 1. Cut petals out of your newspaper. You'll need 5 petals for each flower. Lay down a line of glue and arrange them so they overlap just a little bit.
- 2. Paint the inside of your bottle caps whatever colors you would like.
- 3. Glue your bottle cap in the center of your flower.
- 4. Cut strips of green paper for the stems and glue in place. With a slight wave, cut more of the green paper for the grass.

Earth Day Slime | HF

Materials needed:

- 2 cup hot water
- 1 tsp borax
- ½ cup water, room temperature
- (2) 5 oz bottle of clear glue Elmer's works best
- Blue glitter
- Green glitter
- 2 plastic containers for mixing
- 1 slime container for storing

- 1. Pour 1 cup hot water into a container. Add ½ tsp borax and mix well.
- 2. Pour 1 cup hot water into a container. Add ½ tsp borax and mix well.
- 3. Add in the blue glitter. Stir it all together slowly, but thoroughly. (If you want crystal clear slime skip the glitter and add ins!)
- 4. Pour the glue mixture into the hot water and borax mix. Let it sit for 20-30 seconds.
- 5. The slime will start to form pretty fast in the hot water. Pull it out and put it in your empty bowl. It will be pretty sticky at this point. That's ok!
- 6. Knead it for a few minutes and it will thicken and set.
- 7. Repeat the process, except this time add green glitter instead. Have fun swirling your blue and green slime!
- 8. Store in an airtight container.



Dirt Cups Recipe HF | LF

Materials needed:

- 2 cups milk
- 1 small box instant chocolate pudding
- 1 package Oreos
- 1 small tub Cool Whip
- Gummy Worms
- Clear cups (preferably)

- 1. Place 1/2 a package of Oreos in a Ziploc baggie. Crush them up with your hands or with a rolling pin.
- 2. In a bowl, whisk together the pudding, milk, and about 2/3 1 whole tub of Cool Whip. Allow it to set for about 2 minutes to thicken a bit. Stir again.
- 3. Fill your clear cups about halfway with pudding. Then cover with a layer of oreo.
- 4. Finally, add a couple gummy bears



Egg Carton Tree | LF

Materials needed:

- Egg Carton
- Scissors
- Glue
- Paint
- White Paper or Canvas

- 1. Using your scissors, go ahead and trim out each individual section of the egg carton.
- 2. Paint the egg carton pieces green.
- 3. Paint the trunk of the tree on the canvas.
- 4. Glue the green egg carton pieces to the canvas, to make it look like a tree.
- 5. Now you may choose to add to your tree. You can paint or cut out birds or apples to add to it!



Crown of Grass HF | LF

Materials needed:

- Crayons
- Stapler
- Scissors
- Green Construction Paper
- Stickers

- 1. Cut the piece of green construction in half.
- 2. Then snip the edge of one side of the paper to make grass. If you are concerned about cutting the paper all the way through, draw a line so that you will know where to stop.
- 3. You can continue to trim the edges to make it look more grass like. You can also add come color to make it look more realistic.
- 4. Once the grass is cut add stickers of summer critters, flowers, bugs, birds, and anything else you would like to decorate it with.
- 5. Then staple the two pieces to make one long strip. Size it to your head and staple the other ends together to finish the crown.




Earth Day DJY Crayons HF | LF

Materials needed:

- Old or Unwanted Crayons (blue, green and white)
- Mini Muffin Tin or Heart Shape Mold

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- 1. Remove the wrapper from the crayons
- 2. Break the crayons into pieces that fit inside if your mold



- 4. Bake the crayons for 15-20 minutes at 250 degrees, or follow the directions that come with your silicone molds.
- 5. Let them cool on the counter for about 30 minutes and then place them in the freezer for another 30 minutes, or until the sides of the crayons start to pull away from the sides of the mold.



Cherry Blossom Windsock | HF

Materials needed:

- Toilet Paper Roll
- Construction Paper
- Pink Tissue Paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Paint
- Stapler

- 1. Paint your toilet paper roll light blue. Let it dry.
- 2. Then paint some brown branches over the blue. Let it dry.
- 3. Cut several streamers of pink tissue paper. Glue or staple them to the bottom of your TP roll.
- 4. Cut several squares of pink tissue paper. Scrunch them into a loose ball and glue them onto the branches. Continue scrunching up tissue paper squares and gluing them all over the cherry tree branches until it is full of cherry blossoms.
- 5. Cut a length of pink construction paper 1-inch by 8 1/2-inches. Add a generous amount of glue on one end of the paper strip and attach it inside the top of the windsock. Add glue on the opposite end of the paper strip and attach it to the opposite end of the windsock to create your handle.
- 6. Hang your windsock outside and watch it dance around in the spring wind. Or display the windsock indoors for a colorful spring decoration.



Spring Flower Craft | HF

Materials needed:

- Paint
- Q-Tips
- Blue Paper

- 1. Paint the stocks and leaves with green paint.
- 2. Paint on black lines at the top of the stems for the dandelion centers. If you want, you can also paint some tiny yellow dots on top of the black line to make them look more realistic.
- 3. Take 5 or 6 cotton buds and tape them together, or tie them together using an elastic band. Now you have a bundle of cotton buds that you can print with.
- 4. Dip your tied cotton buds into white paint. Press them down and lift straight up off the paper to avoid smudging. Make these prints all the way round the dandelion center
- As an added touch, you can pick a dandelion which has some seeds blowing off in the wind. To do this you still print all the way around the center but you then leave a small gap at the top.
- 6. Take a single cotton bud and print a little line of dots floating away from your dandelion. That way you can make it look like some dandelion seeds are blowing off in the breeze.




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
Earth Day Color by Number




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
